### DON CARLOS

Perhaps the regal air of Don Carlos Ristorante can be attributed to walls adorned with paintings from the museum of La Scala Opera House, or wine cellar lined with the ancient ruins of a Roman wall dating back to 250AD. Whatever the reason, it is a distinguished setting for your Milan dining experience. The chef focuses on delivering simple menus that are typically Italian, making fresh flavours and ingredients the stars of each plate. Service at Don Carlos is impeccable, with attentive staff providing well-informed food and wine recommendations. From homemade tagliolini sautéed with lobster to rabbit ragout with fresh oregano, there is something to tantalise all tastebuds. Situated in the Grand Hotel, don't be deceived by what could be considered a slightly outdated façade. The minute you step inside you will surrender to Don Carlos' charming character of dimmed lighting and opera music – the perfect fusion of gastronomy and culture.

### TRIENNALE
